DOCENT BOARD MEETING

DATE: January 9, 2013

President Kathryn Padgett called the meeting to order at 9:35AM. The minutes of December 12, 2012 meeting were approved.

BOARD REPORTS

PRESIDENT: Kathryn Padgett

Kathryn informed the Board that the website committee met yesterday to plan the presentation being done at the January 16th meeting. Mike Ramey is currently working on the Latin American show and the other website members continue to upload research papers, pictures, and comments. He will do a presentation of half the website installation at the Docent Council Meeting. She also reported that Mary Ellen Hoffman, Research Chairperson has joined the Website committee.

Kathryn reported that she will be attending the Annual Preview Meeting sponsored by Larry Feinberg, Robert and Mercedes Eicholz Director and Ken Anderson, Chair, Board of Trustees. She will give the Board a full report of this meeting at the February Board Meeting.

She reported the Provisional Class has completed their 3 Minute Talks and there are still 13 Provisionals. This next trimester they will be asked to conduct a student tour, complete a research paper, and do an 8 Minute Talk. Ann Robinson will be letting her Student Team Leaders know the Provisionals will be contacting them with observation and tour requests.

VICE-PRESIDENT: Vikki Duncan

Vikki reported that receipts have been submitted for the reimbursement for the December 10, 2012, Holiday Party. Pending the Treasurer's final report, a tally shows the event coming in under the \$600 budget by approximately \$45.00 a final count of 74 Docents, Provisionals, and Museum staff members attended.

The Docents and Friends Trip to San Francisco is confirmed for the weekend of March 2-3, 2013. Thirty-two docents and friends are on the preliminary sign-up. Tickets are reserved for "The Girl with the Pearl Earring: Dutch Painting from the Maurithuis, and Rembrandt's Century" at the De Young Museum. Discount group hotel rates and opera tickets have been negotiated. Optional activities are planned for those arriving on Friday, March 1st, and staying over till Monday, March 4th. The Social Committee has been reviewing the tentative itinerary and has made suggestions incorporated in the draft circulated to the Board today. Docents will be asked to confirm which activities they will join too, with a deposit requested by February 1st to offset the initial costs to guarantee admission and tour tickets.

Gabriela Schooley is coordinating the Provisional Luncheons this year, and one docent already has stepped forward to host a luncheon. Another invitation to host will be made at the Council Meeting on January 16th. Given the size of the Provisional class, luncheons will be distributed over several months, and may be scheduled as early as February.

Following the announcement in La Muse, email responses are coming in for the proposed Boston trip. We have identified dates of May 2-6 (Thursday through Monday) between the first Docent Council Meeting and the Board meeting in May. Christine Holland is compiling the information for this trip, and docents are engaging family and friends in the greater Boston area to provide helpful information.

RESEARCH: Mary Ellen Hoffman

Mary Ellen reported that she met with the new website committee to better understand what the new site would look like and also to get a better understanding of how research would be presented and made available.

What the real parameters of research for the purposes of the Research Chair position versus the many other types of research done and submitted by others is still an emerging work in progress. It was agreed that one important role of the position is to identify the "holes" in our permanent collection where papers are needed and to be the one to request papers from the provisional class (as opposed to requests emanating from the curatorial staff as is the current practice) and to encourage current docents to identify needs and do research as well. In both instances the papers would be vetted by a curator.

Loree Gold is still in charge of seeing what exists in the paper files that may actually fill some of those perceived holes, especially with regard to the new Latin American exhibit, Myth & Materiality. (Note that 14 papers were found in the paper file on works contained in Scenery, Story, and Spirit).

Mike Ramey, the webmaster, is committed to getting all research available on upcoming exhibits posted by the time the exhibit goes up.

Sue reported that of this date she will be notifying evaluators of assignments coming up to be evaluated in this New Year and to be in touch with their docents.
