BOARD REPORTS

PRESIDENT: Kathryn Padgett

Kathryn thanked the Board for their co-operation and help at the recent Recruitment Tea. There were only tours with no visitors however, and both were Thursday Highlights. All were highlights and two were on Saturdays.
