Overview

SBMA is proud to share the newly constructed Works on Paper Study Center with visitors, featuring an inaugural exhibition of *Important Works on Paper from the Permanent Collection*. Showcasing drawings, photographs, and prints from all four Museum departments, this opening installation represents the breadth and variety of the permanent collection, both chronologically and geographically.

Davidson and Colefax Galleries will be devoted to rotations of works on paper, allowing for the display of rarely shown artworks and new discoveries. This is an exciting opportunity to shed new light on artworks which are usually kept out of view, precisely because they are so sensitive to light. The Center will celebrate the ways in which these delicate and precious works offer unique insights into the artistic process, from the intimacy of drawing and painting on paper, to the technical innovations of printmaking and photography.
