

KEY for Student Touring Calendars

Monthly Calendars are distributed on or around the 15th of each month for the next month's planning purposes. Updated calendars are supplied near the first of the month with any changes. The calendar is subject to change until two weeks before the tour date. We do our best to adhere to it, but changes do sometimes occur. Flexibility is our mantra!

Cell Color: Days of the week are shaded differently for ease in reading.

- Tuesday = White
- Wednesday= **Orange**
- Thursday = **Blue**
- Friday = **Yellow**

Font Color: Colored fonts indicate a tour on site that we think you should be aware of, but not one that requires you to be responsible for touring.

- **Green Font = Young at Art (YA)** tours. These are full classes of K-2 students who will tour with a SBMA Teaching Artist during the last 30 minutes of their 90 minute class. So a 10am YAA class will be in the galleries from 11-11:30am, or an 11:30am class will be in the galleries from 12:30-1pm.
- **Red Font = Special Request (SR)** tours. These are often in the afternoon. We may ask for additional help for these tours, so they are important to be aware of.

- AM = Artful Making. Tour + art activity in the Family Resource Center (FRC)
- AT = Artful Thinking. Tour only, starts and ends on the front steps
- FF = Fridays in Focus. High school tours with guest speakers
- SR = Special Request. See above regarding the red font
- YA = Young at Art. Younger students do a separate program without docents
- NEW this year: ML = Mindful Looking. Meditation in the galleries, no tour
